



Antique Chestnut Flooring

Product Description

Chestnut is the most popular of our reclaimed flooring. This product offers the natural beauty of chestnut and a wonderful array of added character is gained from the wood's history. Nail-holes, worm-tracks and color variations along with a few knots combine to create a floor that is both rustic and refined.

- ◆ Specifications are designed to create an overall appearance of a floor and do not always apply to each individual board.
- ◆ **Specie**-American Chestnut.
- ◆ **Source**-Generally 19th century barns.
- ◆ **Moisture**-Dried to less than 8% mc.
- ◆ **Knots**-Unlimited sound knots, some open knots.
- ◆ **Holes**-May Contain many nail holes often with ferrous stain and frequent insect holes and tracks.
- ◆ **Check**-unlimited checks and cracks allowed as long as each piece is sound.
- ◆ **Surface**-Limited surface area may have saw-marks or weathering.
- ◆ **Grain**-Mixed grain patterns.
- ◆ **Color**-Unlimited color variations, usually tan to brown to dark brown.
- ◆ **Millwork**-Flooring, Tongue & Groove, back relief, square ends.
- ◆ **Sizes**-3/4" thick, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10" wide, 1-1/2' - 12' long. Occasionally, thicknesses and widths must be adjusted to accommodate raw product.
