

# Antique Oak Flooring

## Product Description

Antique Oak Flooring is the most refined of our oak flooring. The evidence of the wood's history is limited, but may include nail holes, small bolt holes, insect tracks, enriched patina, attractive checking, remnants of weathering and more. When these elements are combined with the natural beauty of the wood, a floor is created that fits into a host of uses.

- ◆ Specifications are designed to create an overall appearance of a floor and do not always apply to each individual board.
- ◆ Specie-White Oak & Red Oak.
- ◆ Source-Generally 19th century barns.
- ◆ Moisture-Dried to less than 8% mc.
- ◆ Knots-Unlimited sound knots and some broken knots.
- ◆ Holes-May include some nail holes often with ferrous stains; could contain frequent insect holes and trails.
- ◆ Checks-Unlimited checks and cracks allowed as long as individual pieces are sound.
- ◆ Surface-Limited surface area may have saw marks and original weathering.
- ◆ Grain-Mixed grain patterns.
- ◆ Color-Limited variation from brown to tan to red and black staining.
- ◆ Millwork-Flooring, Tongue & Groove, back relief, square ends.
- ◆ Sizes-3/4" thick, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10" wide, 1-1/2' - 12' long. Occasionally, thicknesses and widths must be adjusted to accommodate raw product.

The unique distinctiveness of a reclaimed wood floor is generally what makes it so desirable. A sample, photograph or description of a particular type of wood flooring may demonstrate the general characteristics. The sample, photograph or description may not necessarily be representative of the product actually delivered due to the great variability in color, grain, texture, sign of previous use, etc.
